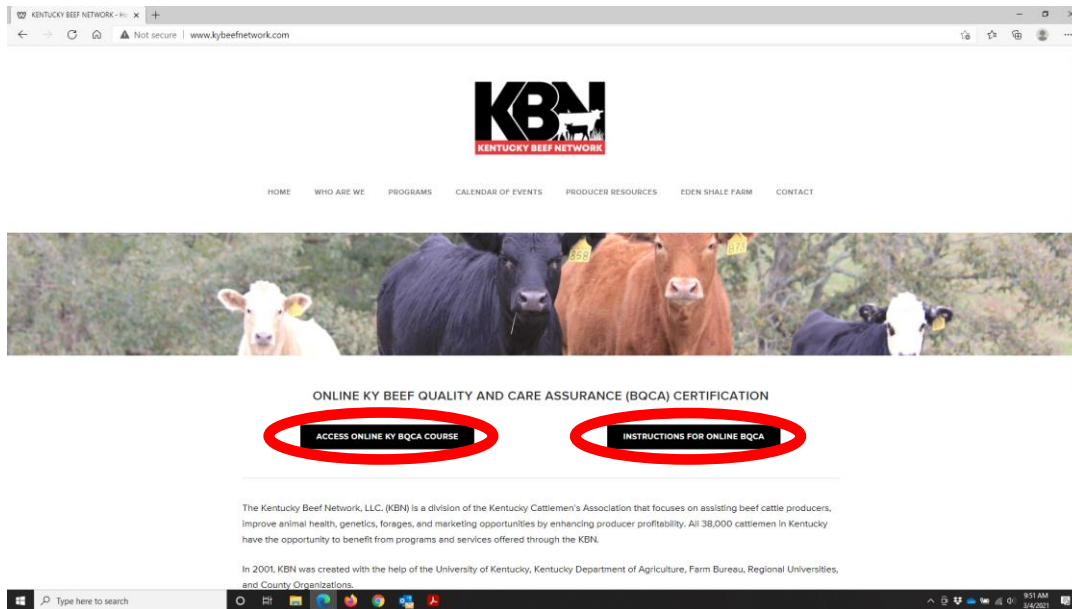


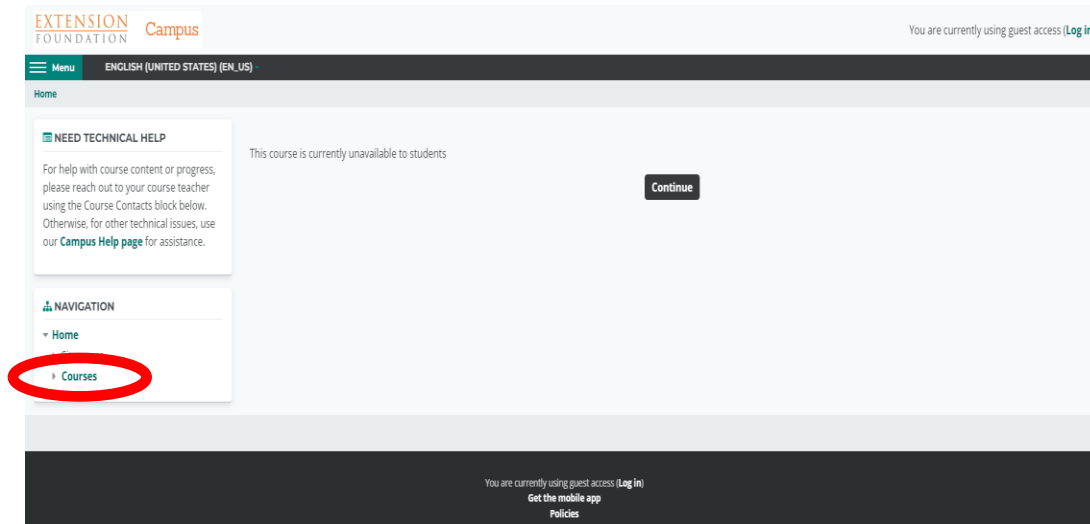
# Instructions for Enrolling the KY BQCA Course in the Online Learning Environment

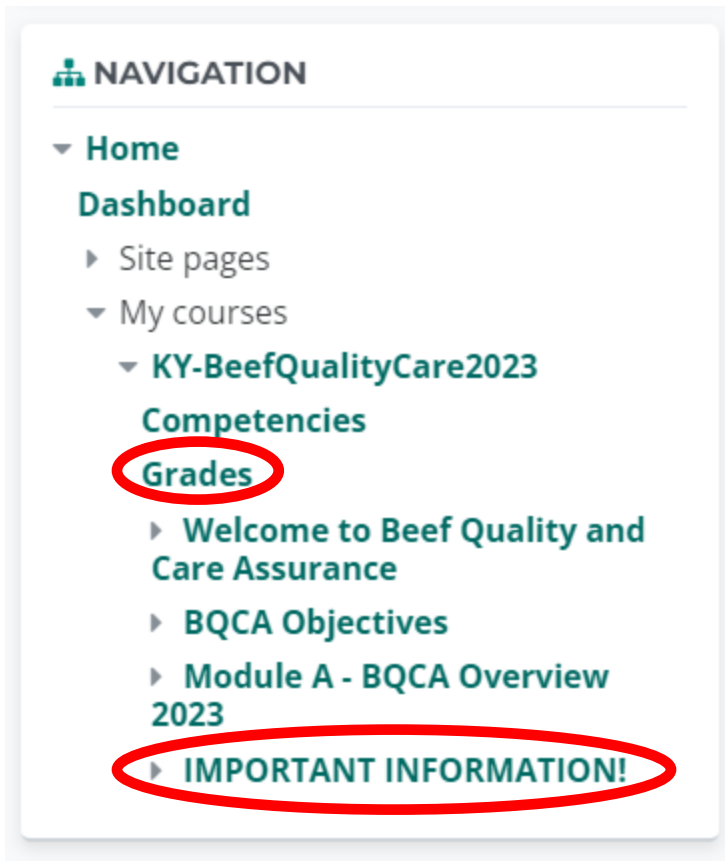
